• Sharing & Taking turns, Costume Day, लिखित अभ्यास (अक्षर ल), Letter Mm, Structured conversation using vocabulary words, Writing letter Nn, Sight words (This & That), Recognition of numbers 16-20, Pre number concept (In- Out), Find the difference, Complete the figure, Gross motor skill activity, Role play (Doctor's clinic/Grocery Shop)

However, Prayer, Namaskar, Gayatri mantra and Exercises will be a regular feature.

Greeting "NAMASKAR"

The utmost important aspect of the development of "Social Skills" and values amongst our children is teaching to Greet each other.

Greeting each other is another way to build a positive school culture. The act also helps build relationships between students and teachers, which is an important part of making connections for learning for the rest of the day. The act also builds a sense of community in the classroom. So, let's emphasise on children how to say "NAMASKAR' 'regularly.

them gratitude and to be thankful. So let's make our children learn the prayer and sing it.

Use of three magic words, Taking turns & Sharing

Happiness is

Children need to be emphasised the importance of using the three magic words- Sorry, Please and Thank you in their language. Let the children realise their mistakes and learn to apologise. Children learn politeness when they make use of the word 'Please'. They learn the basic etiquettes by making use of the word 'Thank you'



Sharing is a value which is to be inculcated in the children at an early age for enhancing their social development.

Children should learn to wait for their turn as it develops patience in the child.

Visual Discrimination




Find 5 differences

Children enjoy observing and analysing what they see in their environment. It is the ability of an individual to recognize the details in visual images and be able to find the differences and likeness of objects, colours, shapes and size. This skill improves as the child grows. Encourage the child to perceive and interpret what he/she observes.

The child develops his cognitive skills through logical or critical thinking exercises. They may be enabled to put on their thinking cap to attempt the activities such as finding the odd one out, Finding the differences between two pictures and completing the given picture.

Chinese Whisper



Children may be encouraged to play a game of **Chinese Whisper** among their family members. Names of Summer fruits, vegetables and appliances can be spoken one by one into the ears of the players and the last player has to speak aloud what was said to him/her. It would enhance the memory skills of the child.

Costume Day

Children may be motivated to dress up and speak lines on objects we use during Summer season during the virtual circle time. It would enhance their speaking skills and creativity.




Recognition of the letter Mm may be taken up with the help of a game- Treasure Hunt

It is always fun teaching kids through activity and games and one of the best and fun way of helping your child develop much needed life skills such as problem solving and getting some good exercise for both the mind and body is through Treasure Hunt. This self-directed activity that empowers the child to complete a task on their own.

In this game the child will listen to the rhyming clues and find the things at home which begin with letter M.

They may be motivated to write in their prescribed notebooks (Page no. 7-12) **Vocabulary bag** Furniture, Television, Almirah, Bed, Sofa, Toys etc. Bharat and Bharati are staying at home and taking all the safety measures. 



Activity- Ice Tray Number Game

- To play this game, 1 ice tray is required with 10 frames.
- Write a number at the bottom of each frame with a marker.
- Let the child count and put the buttons /Shells/Pompom according to the numbers.




Eg: Four buttons will go in the space with number 4 written in the bottom.

FINE MOTOR SKILLS

❖ ACTIVITY: PASTA THREADING

Material Required- Pasta, Cardboard, Shoe Lace, and Fevicol.

Directions: Make any shape with the cardboard star, heart, or triangle.

Put fevicol on the edges of the shape and paste pasta on it. Make sure to leave space for lacing.

Once all the pastas are stuck to the cardboard now use the shoe lace for lacing. Insert your lace into each hole of pasta to create shape.

Learning Achieved-Fine Motor Skills, Eye hand coordination, Concentration, Pincer grasp practice, Strengthening hand muscles



Activity- Kick the cup

Material Required- Small ball, Plastic Cup, Marker

Setting Up-

- Write a letter on each plastic cup with permanent marker.
- Line the cup in a row on the floor.
- The child will kick the ball towards the cup after that the child has to identify the letter and its sound.
- The child can also aim for a specific cup and letter. He has to knock cups down until there are no cups left in the row.

Child will learn:

Identifying letters
Identifying letter sound
Develop gross motor skills





Setting Up the Kick the Cup Alphabet Activity






CREATIVE EXPRESSION

Mother's Day Card Making

Mother's Day card Child photo - Holding Flower Card. This cute craft for kids will make a wonderful gift for the upcoming Mother's Day. A cute and personal idea.

Material required for making Mother's Day card Activity

- 1. Cut out the card base on fold two circles with radius 4 cm and flower stem (sample sheet attached).
- **2.** Take thirteen strips of length 10 cm and width 1cm.
- **3.** One bowl with little Fevicol and one paint brush.
- **4.** One stamp size photo of child.



Steps required for making Mother's Day card Activity

- 1. Add a bit of glue on one end of paper strip, and stick the ends together forming a teardrop loop.
- 2. Apply glue on card base and stick on the paper loops.
- 3. Paste the photograph of child in the centre.
- 4. Take marker to write message "I Love My Mom".



Cooking Without Fire

Biscuit canapes A delicious and savoury small finger food with tasty and decorative topping. It is also a perfect "cooking without fire".

Ingredients: One pack salted biscuit One onion and tomato finely chopped. 1/4th spoon chat masala One spoon tomato sauce. One small cup sev and grated cheese.

Recipe 1. Mix both the ingredients onion and tomato in a bowl.

- 2. Now add some chat masala.
- 3. Line the biscuit on a plate. Take half tablespoon of tomato sauce and spread on biscuits. 4. Now place a tablespoon of mixture prepared on biscuits.
- 5. Sprinkle some sev and created cheese on top of it. Biscuit canapes are ready.
