Our school has a permanent Book ATM and Utility Bank where students were free to leave books and utility items for donation.

The school was the first Indian School to take part in a coding camp with *Code for Life*, Ocado group(UK) on January 25, 2022, in a virtual meeting. Laura Cumming (Representative Ocado Group) gave a demo and explained all the details of the coding camp, facilitating registration of students. The camp taught new coders the basic principles to help them thrive in an increasingly digital world.
