MAKING MODELS BY PLAY DOUGH (JULY 5, 2022)

a) Students of Class IX were engaged in group activity as a part of experiential learning, wherein they prepared models of plant and animal cell using play dough. As a group activity, not only it strengthened team work and collaboration, where underachievers could learn from their peers about the different components of cell, but also provided a boost to their kinesthetic

intelligence.
