It's time to inspire action through Climate Education!

To ensure that our kids can adapt to and limit the impacts of climate change, the school in association with RUNNING OUT OF TIME, is celebrating Global Schools Action Week from November 1-3, 2022.

Running Out of Time is a 7,767km non-stop relay from Glasgow, Scotland (Host of COP26) to Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt (Host of COP27). The relay runs day and night for 38 days and travels to 18 countries including India.

The three days event will offer students an unforgettable opportunity to join the call for universal Quality Climate Education, take part in a range of fun activities, and engage with programmes and resources from the world's leading environmental education organisations.

CLASS	ACTIVITY/ COMPETITION	DATE	DESCRIPTION
I	Build a chain	2.11.22	Students will make a chain wearing climate themed headgears in the school ground and pass the baton around while voicing climate themed slogans.
II	Themed laps (Competition)	3.11.22	Students will dress up as climate warriors, present themselves and run/bounce or hop on the relay track in the school ground.
III	Design your sustainable relay baton (Competition)	1.11.22	Design a relay baton using only compostable and recyclable materials.
IV	Get moving	3.11.22	The students will run on a relay track in the school with their climate themed batons.
V	The Greenhouse Effect (Competition)	2.11.22	The teachers will explain the concept of greenhouse effect to the students which will be followed by a poster making competition on the same. (Don't forget to write slogans and your climate action message on your posters.)

The messages and voices of our little climate warriors will be shared on Running Out of Time's webpage. This is a great opportunity for our students to unite with the kids around the world, demonstrate how local actions have global impacts, and be heard at COP27!
