The online virtual library, with resources and services, is available 24X7 on smart phone through the link: **BBPSDW_Jr.Lib/Linktree**, which has received over 9000 views as on October 10, 2022.

The platform boasts of a number of interactive features including:

- **Recommend a book to your friends**: Children can read interesting books and spread a word about them by posting their reviews. The feature is gaining popularity as a virtual book readers' club and has garnered much appreciation from the parent community.
- **Books I want you to read**: Talking cognizance of the reading level and interest of learners, teachers recommend books from a wide variety of genres to children. The platform provides a space for teachers and students to engage in this academic endeavour outside the classroom.
- Teachers' Corner: Teachers can access National Digital Library (NDL), CBSE Handbooks and NCERT Portal to keep themselves abreast with latest pedagogy and as a ready referral.
