CBSE has modified the Assessment \& Evaluation Practices from the current Academic Session which will be followed by the schools running under DoE as per details given below:

## ATTENDANCE

Every student must have a minimum of $75 \%$ attendance, failing which he/she will not be allowed to sit in the final examination/will not be promoted to the next higher class, as per the CBSE guidelines.
Please discourage the student from missing an exam except on grounds of extreme emergency like a contagious disease, fracture etc. for which a medical certificate from a certified government hospital practitioner and supporting medical reports must be submitted within one week of the absence.

## PROMOTION POLICY AND CUMULATIVE RESULT

The Theory Cumulative total is computed as follows:

| COMPONENT | WEIGHTAGE (\%) |
| :--- | :--- |
| THE BEST TWO OF THE THREE PTs | 20 |
| Half Yearly | 20 |
| Annual | 60 |
| Total | $\mathbf{1 0 0}$ |

The numerical sum of the above weighted scores will be converted on a base of 80/70/60/40/30 as per the CBSE norms for that specific subject theory component.

## PASS CRITERIA

In order to be declared as having passed the Class XI Examination, the student must have obtained:
A. A minimum of $33 \%$ marks in Theory Cumulative total and $33 \%$ in Practical INDIVIDUALLY for all the subjects.
B. The school will have 3 rounds of Periodic Tests. The best two of the three Periodic tests will be considered for the cumulative assessment.
C. Minimum subject wise score of $33 \%$ in Annual Examination (Theory).

Both these criteria (A and C) must be fulfilled for a child to be declared passed and promoted.

## ADDITIONAL SUBJECTS

It is mandatory for a student to pass in the additional subject in class XI as per passing criteria above. For students who are unable to meet the passing criteria, a retest will be scheduled. Failure to fulfill the passing criteria after retest will lead to surrender of the additional subject in Class XII.

## RE-EXAMINATION/COMPARTMENT/ DETENTION (CLASS-XI):

A) A candidate obtaining less than $33 \%$ in one subject only will qualify for a retest in the specific subject.
B) A candidate securing less than $33 \%$ in the retest shall be detained. In case of detention, no change of subject is permitted.
C) A candidate obtaining less than $33 \%$ in two or more subjects will be detained. In case of detention, no change of subject is permitted.

## MISSED TEST/ EXAMS

A) If a student has missed Periodic Tests, there will be no retest.
B) Attendance is mandatory for Mid Term and Annual Exam.
C) If a student is On Duty or has missed the Annual exam due to genuine medical reasons, retest shall be conducted only once and shall be held as per the declared schedule.

## USE OF UNFAIR MEANS

Strict disciplinary action will be taken against students using unfair means. Their answer scripts will be cancelled, and a new answer script will be issued and no extra time will be given. Only the new answer script will be assessed. Repeated unfair means will invite major penalization.

## ASSESSMENT OF CO-SCHOLASTIC AREAS:

Assessment of co-scholastic areas will be done as per CBSE guidelines.
