The curriculum changes that the school has integrated and adopted are as follows:

- 1. **Skill Development** as an integral part of the curriculum, focusing on practical skills such as communication, financial literacy, digital literacy, and vocational skills.
- 2. **Multidisciplinary Approach** to promote critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- 3. **Bridge Courses** for classes 3 and 6 to ensure continuity and change across Stages due to new textbooks.
- 4. Inclusive Education by providing support and accommodations for students with disabilities, ensuring their participation and access to quality education.
- 5. Assessment Reforms to move away from rote memorization and encourage competency-based evaluations focusing on skill development and application of knowledge. (Refer to PPT with Class Teacher for detailed design).
- 6. **Internal Assessment** as an integral part for motivating students to explore beyond textbooks.
- 7. **Technology Integration** in education, leveraging digital platforms and tools to enhance learning experiences, provide personalized learning, and access relevant resources.

Education 8. Environmental as cross-cutting theme foster a to environmental awareness, sustainability, and conservation practices among students.

9. Regular Orientation Sessions for parents (online and offline) to build

relationships with parents and the community.

10. Development of **innovative learning materials** for engaging the

students.

11. Introduction of Artificial Intelligence across all classes to upgrade and

update our students with the ever-changing technology.

12. Experiential Learning: Focus on experiential, inquiry, and discovery-

based teaching-learning methods.

13. **Integrated Pedagogy**: Arts, sports, and story-telling and ICT-integrated

pedagogy for holistic development of students.

14. **Promotion of peer tutoring**: Promoting peer tutoring as a voluntary and

joyful activity under the supervision of teachers.

15. Bagless Days: Bagless days have been scheduled in the academic

calendar for the development of skills.

16. **No Gadget Zone**: In sync with CBSE policy, smartphones are prohibited in

school. Responsible use of gadgets is promoted through various digital

wellness activities.
