

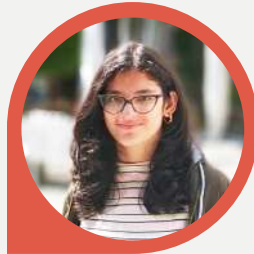

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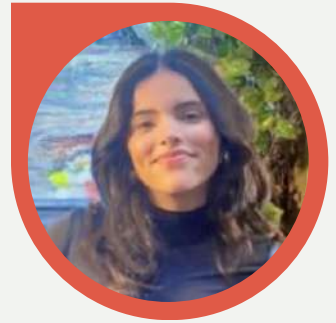
DAWN OF REJOICE

never fail to treat us like our father or mother

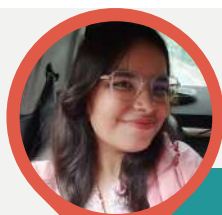
They keep hoping

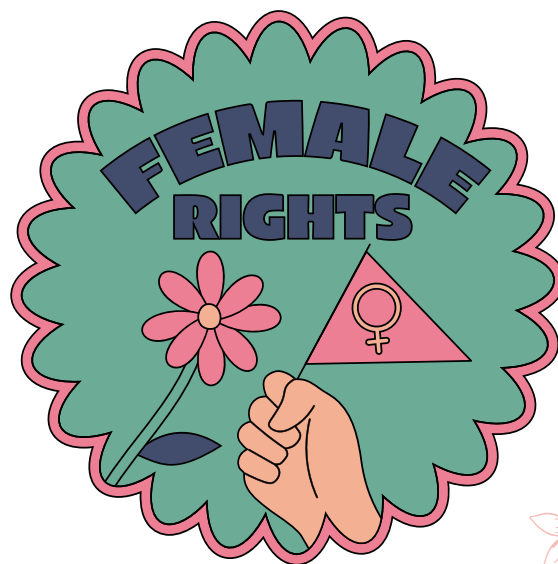

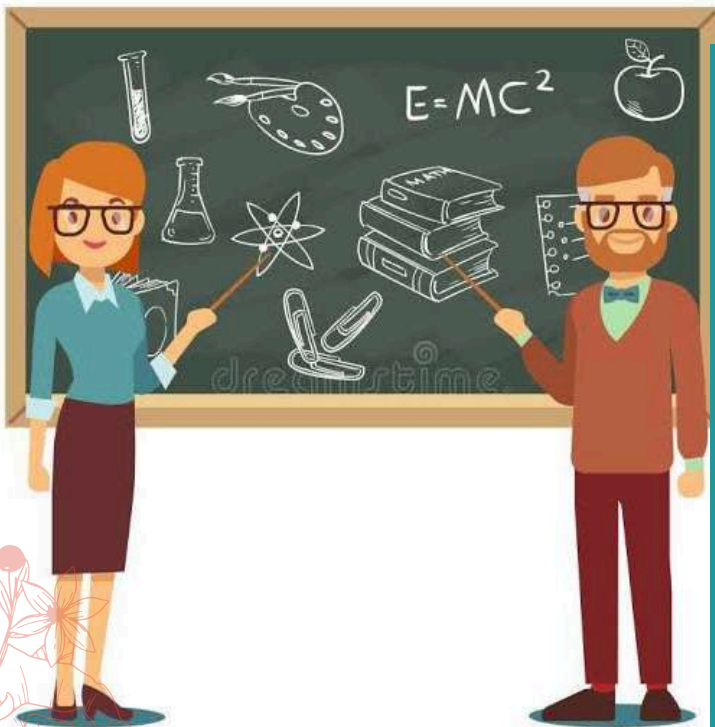
