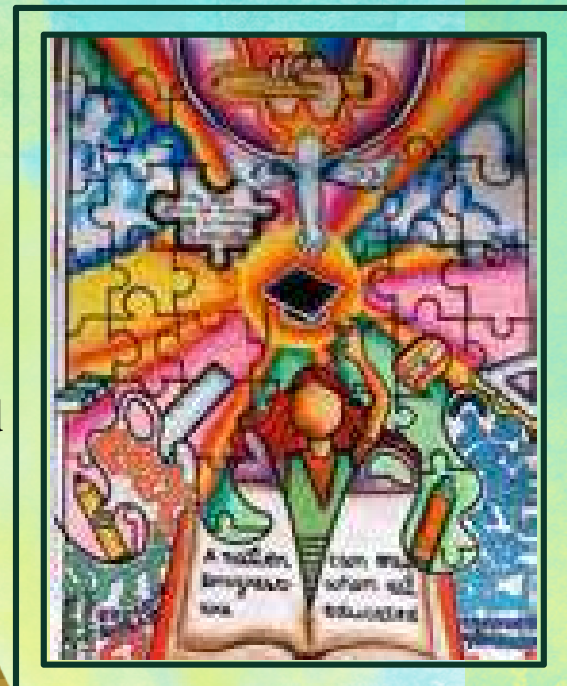

## A KALEIDOSCOPIC VIEW THROUGH THE PRISM OF WORDS

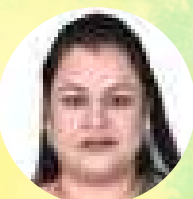
