**STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS AS PER CBSE
EXAMINATION BYE-LAWS FOR BOARD EXAMINATION**

Dear Parent,

- I. It is well understood that schools are not just centers for academic learning but play a critical role in the overall development of students. Along with imparting subject knowledge, schools facilitate extracurricular activities, peer learning, character building, values inculcation, teamwork, collaboration, respecting diversity, inclusion, and many more. Therefore, the regular attendance of students in the school is vital to ensuring their holistic development.

As per the Board's regulations, a minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory for students to be eligible to appear for the Board examinations. The Board offers a 25% relaxation only in cases of exigencies such as medical emergencies, participation in national or international sports events, and other serious reasons, provided the necessary documentation is submitted.

- II. Many students are being lured by coaching institutes to attend non attending schools that give attendance. However, it is to bring to your notice that no school is allowed to offer non attending attendance as per CBSE bye laws. (Press Release by CBSE attached)

You are requested to ensure that your ward attends school regularly and completes 75% attendance as per norms.

CBSE Conducts Surprise Inspections across five States and one Union Territory

New Delhi, December 19, 2024 – The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) conducted surprise inspections at 29 schools across six regions on December 18 and 19, 2024, as part of its commitment to uphold educational standards. The inspections were carried out in Delhi on December 18 and in Bengaluru (Karnataka), Patna (Bihar), Bilaspur (Chhattisgarh), Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh), and Ahmedabad (Gujarat) on December 19.

A total of 29 teams, comprising a CBSE officer and a principal from an affiliated school, conducted these inspections in a synchronized manner within a limited time frame to ensure the element of surprise and the accuracy of findings.

The primary objective of these inspections was to evaluate compliance with CBSE's norms and Affiliation Bye-Laws. The inspection teams focused on verifying student enrollment records, infrastructure facilities, and the overall functioning of the schools.

Majority of the inspected schools were found to have violated the Board's Affiliation Bye-Laws by enrolling students beyond their actual attendance records, effectively creating "non-attending" enrolments. Additionally, schools were found to be flouting infrastructural norms of the Board.

CBSE has taken these violations seriously and is in the process of issuing show-cause notices to the schools found in breach of regulations. The Board is also considering legal action against the defaulting institutions.

CBSE reaffirms its commitment to maintaining the highest educational standards and ensuring strict compliance with its regulations. These inspections mark a significant step in the Board's ongoing efforts to ensure transparency, accountability, and adherence to its guidelines by all affiliated schools.
