
<u>Activity time</u>

Activity time

- <u>Choose your jungle buddy:</u>Let your ward pick either a Giraffe or a Tiger or any other buddy for making a pencil holder.
- **<u>Cover the Rolls</u>**: Wrap each cardboard roll in colored paper (yellow for giraffe and orange for tiger). Glue it neatly.
- <u>Add Animal Features</u>: Cut and stick ears, eyes, nose, mouth, tail, horns or spots/stripes using paper or marker.
- Paste googly eyes and draw a big smile.
- Fix the Rolls to the base: Paste the decorated rolls on a cardboard base to keep it steady.
- Decorate the pencil holder with small leaves, grass and place it on the study table.

This holiday season, let's celebrate the spirit of the jungle as we prepare for a wild and wonderful Mowgli's birthday party! We invite our little ones to make a jungle animal pencil holder inspired by Mowgli's animal friends. This fun activity will spark creativity and jungle excitement!
