As you prepare for your Examinations, we would like to strictly remind that the school upholds the highest standards of honesty, integrity, and discipline.

Any form of cheating - possession of copying material or barred items like mobile phone/smart watches etc, communication with others during the examination, tearing of pages of the answer booklet, taking/giving assistance to other mates is highly discouraged and if occurs, will be treated as **Unfair Means (UFM)**.

This will result in **strict disciplinary action** as per Board guidelines laid in the circular dated 20.01.25 which will negatively impact the student's academic record.

The Centre Superintendent may choose to take any of the following disciplinary actions

- Immediate & mandatory reporting to Board authorities
- Cancellation of current Examination in the concerned subject
- You may have to take the compartment exam or appear for examinations again the next academic year
- You may even be debarred from appearing in Board Examination for next three years. In case of any disciplinary action, the school will not be able to help you and you will be penalised as per rules without any consideration to your previous record.

Examinations are not only a test of knowledge, but also of character. Your effort, sincerity, and preparation define your success — not shortcuts.

We strongly encourage you to:

- Trust your preparation.
- Follow all examination rules carefully.
- Maintain discipline inside and outside the examination hall.
- Report any concerns to the invigilator
